*SUBJECT: Annual Crime Analysis Report for 2008*

*The annual report includes general information on **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** crimes reported and investigated by the Guilford Police Department. The report also includes information on motor vehicle enforcement, accidents, and alarm cases investigated by this agency from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008 to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008. A comparison on all information is also listed for the previous year.*

### **Calls for Service**

During 2008 the Guilford Police Department received **13,223** calls for service. Of these calls the following information has been formulated for your review. There were **(736)** criminal arrests.

### **Burglary Cases**

There were a total of fifty-nine **(59)** burglaries reported during this period. The majority of which were residential in nature. During the same period for 2007 there were fifty two **(52)** reported burglaries in the jurisdiction. *This was a 13% increase from the previous year.*

### **Criminal Mischief Cases:**

There were a total of two hundred and forty-eight **(248)** criminal mischief complaints reported during this period. The majority of which were private property and or mailbox damage. During the same period for 2007 there were three hundred and thirty-eight **(338)** cases reported. *This was a 27% reduction from the previous year.*

### **Larceny Cases:**

There were a total of three hundred and twelve (**312**) larceny complaints filed during this period. The majority of which were classified as general larceny in nature. During the same period for 2007 there were two hundred and ninety-two (**292**) cases reported. This was a **7%** increase from the previous year.

### **Motor Vehicle Enforcement**

There were a total of (**3,214**) motor vehicle violations investigated during this period. During the same period for 2007 there were (**3,323**) cases investigated. This was a **3%** reduction from the previous year.

There were **41 DWI** arrests in 2008 and **48 DWI** arrests in 2007 a **14%** reduction.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents**

There were a total of (**682**) motor vehicle accidents investigated during this period. Three (**3**) of these were fatal. During the same period for 2007 there were **765** motor vehicle accidents investigated, none of which were fatal. This was a **11%** reduction from the previous year.

During this reporting period there were **202** child safety seats installed by officers of this department.

### **Narcotics/Drugs**

There were a total of fifty-six (**56**) drug related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2007 there were (**58**) cases investigated. This was a **3%** reduction from the previous year.

### **Sex Crimes Cases:**

There were a total of eleven (**11**) sex crime related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2007 there were fourteen (**14**) cases investigated. This was a **21%** reduction from the previous year.

**Robbery Cases:**

There were a total of three (3) robberies cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2007 there were two (2) cases investigated. This was a 50% increase from the previous year.

**Alarms All types**

The department responded to a total of 1,700 alarms during this period. During the same period for 2007 the department responded to a total of 1,550 alarms. This was a 9% reduction from the previous year.
