*SUBJECT: Annual Crime Analysis Report for 2009*

*The annual report includes general information on **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** crimes reported and investigated by the Guilford Police Department. The report also includes information on motor vehicle enforcement, accidents, and alarm cases investigated by this agency from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009. A comparison on all information is also listed for the previous year.*

### **Calls for Service**

During 2009 the Guilford Police Department received **12,383** calls for service. Of these calls the following information has been formulated for your review. There were **(579)** criminal arrests. During the same period in 2008 there were **13,223** calls for service and **(736)** criminal arrests. This was a reduction of **6%** in calls for service and a reduction of **21%** for criminal arrests from the previous year..

### **Burglary Cases**

There were a total of sixty-seven **(67)** burglaries reported during this period. The majority of which were residential in nature. During the same period for 2008 there were fifty-nine **(59)** reported burglaries in the jurisdiction. *This was a **13%** increase from the previous year.*

### **Criminal Mischief Cases:**

There were a total of two hundred and ninety **(290)** criminal mischief complaints reported during this period. The majority of which were private property and or mailbox damage. During the same period for 2008 there were two hundred and forty-eight **(248)** cases reported. *This was a **17%** increase from the previous year.*

### **Larceny Cases:**

There were a total of three hundred and two (**302**) larceny complaints filed during this period. The majority of which were classified as general larceny in nature. During the same period for 2008 there were three hundred and twelve (**312**) cases reported. This was a **3%** reduction from the previous year.

### **Motor Vehicle Enforcement**

There were a total of (**2923**) motor vehicle violations investigated during this period. During the same period for 2008 there were (**3,214**) cases investigated. This was a **9%** reduction from the previous year.

There were **42 DWI** arrests in 2009 and **41 DWI** arrests in 2008 a **2%** increase.

### **Motor Vehicle Accidents**

There were a total of (**657**) motor vehicle accidents investigated during this period. One (**1**) of these was fatal. During the same period for 2008 there were (**682**) motor vehicle accidents investigated, (**3**) of which were fatal. There was a **66%** reduction in fatal accidents. The total decrease in accidents was **4%** overall.

During this reporting period there were **202** child safety seats installed by officers of this department.

### **Narcotics/Drugs**

There were a total of twenty-four (**24**) drug related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2008 there were (**56**) cases investigated. This was a **57%** reduction from the previous year.

### **Sex Crimes Cases:**

There were a total of twelve (**12**) sex crime related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2008 there were eleven (**11**) cases investigated. This was a **9%** increase from the previous year.

**Robbery Cases:**

There were a total of four (4) robberies cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2008 there were three (3) cases investigated. This was a 33% increase from the previous year.

**Alarms All types**

The department responded to a total of 1,523 alarms during this period. During the same period for 2008 the department responded to a total of 1,700 alarms. This was a 10% reduction from the previous year.

**Murder Cases:**

None reported

**Arson Cases:**

There was (1) reported arson in 2009. During 2008 no arsons were reported.
