SUBJECT: Annual Crime Analysis Report for 2011

The annual report includes general information on **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** crimes reported and investigated by the Guilford Police Department. The report also includes information on motor vehicle enforcement, accidents, and alarm cases investigated by this agency from **January 1st, 2011 to December 31st, 2011**. A comparison on all information is also listed for the previous year.

Calls for Service

During 2011 the Guilford Police Department received **13,153** calls for service. Of these calls the following information has been formulated for your review. During the same period in 2010 there were **13,272** calls for service. This was a decrease of less than one percent in calls for service from the previous year.

Burglary Cases

There were a total of sixty-seven (67) burglaries reported during this period. The majority of which were residential in nature. During the same period for 2010 there were seventy-six (76) reported burglaries in the jurisdiction. This was a 13% decrease from the previous year.

Criminal Mischief Cases:

There were a total of two hundred and two (202) criminal mischief complaints reported during this period. The majority of which were private property and or mailbox damage. During the same period for 2010 there were two hundred and forty-four (244) cases reported. This was a 17% decrease from the previous year.

Larceny Cases:

There were a total of four hundred and fifty-three (453) larceny complaints filed during this period. The majority of which were classified as general larceny in nature. In addition identify theft cases, and fraud cases have been added to this year's report. During the same period for 2010 there were three hundred and eighty-seven (387) cases reported. This was a 17% increase from the previous year.

Motor Vehicle Enforcement

There was a total of (2,994) motor vehicle violations investigated during this period. During the same period for 2010 there were (3,474) cases investigated. This was a 14% decrease from the previous year.

There were 55 DWI arrests in 2011 and 40 DWI arrests in 2010 a 37% increase.

Motor Vehicle Accidents

There was a total of (746) motor vehicle accidents investigated during this period. One (1) of these was fatal. During the same period for 2010 there were (694) motor vehicle accidents investigated, (2) of which were fatal. There was a 50% decrease in fatal accidents. The total increase in accidents was 7% overall.

During this reporting period there were **195** child safety seats installed by officers of this department. During the same period for 2010 there were **266** child safety seats installed. A **27%** decrease from the previous year.

Narcotics/Drugs

There were a total of thirty-two (32) drug related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2010 there were (26) cases investigated. This was a 23% increase from the previous year.

Sex Crimes Cases:

There were a total of ten (10) sex crime related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2010 there were nine (9) cases investigated. This was an 11% increase from the previous year.

Robbery Cases:

There was one (1) robbery case investigated during this period. During the same period for 2010 there were two (2) cases investigated. This was a 50% decrease from the previous year.

<u>Alarms All types</u>

The department responded to a total of **1,730** alarms during this period. During the same period for 2010 the department responded to a total of **1,711** alarms. This was a **1%** increase from the previous year.
