SUBJECT: Annual Crime Analysis Report for 2012

The annual report includes general information on **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** crimes reported and investigated by the Guilford Police Department. The report also includes information on motor vehicle enforcement, accidents, and alarm cases investigated by this agency from **January 1st, 2012 to December 31st, 2012**. A comparison on all information is also listed for the previous year.

Calls for Service

During 2012 the Guilford Police Department received **12,386** calls for service. Of these calls the following information has been formulated for your review. During the same period in 2011 there were **13,153** calls for service. This was a decrease of almost **6 %** in calls for service from the previous year.

Burglary Cases

There were a total of fifty-eight (58) burglaries reported during this period. The majority of which were residential in nature. During the same period for 2011 there were sixty-seven (67) reported burglaries in the jurisdiction. This was a 14% decrease from the previous year.

Criminal Mischief Cases:

There were a total of two hundred and twenty-three (223) criminal mischief complaints reported during this period. The majority of which were private property and or mailbox damage. During the same period for 2011 there were two hundred and two (202) cases reported. This was a 10% increase from the previous year.

Larceny Cases:

There were a total of four hundred and seventy-eight (**478**) larceny complaints filed during this period. The majority of which were classified as general larceny in nature. In addition identify theft cases, and fraud cases have been added to this year's report. During the same period for 2011 there were four hundred and fifty-three (**453**) cases reported. This was a 5% increase from the previous year.

<u>Motor Vehicle Enforcement</u>

There was a total of (**3,148**) motor vehicle violations investigated during this period. During the same period for 2011 there were (**2,994**) cases investigated. This was a **5%** increase from the previous year.

There were fifty-two (52) **DWI** arrests in 2012, and fifty-five (55) **DWI** arrests in 2011. This was a 5 % decrease from the previous year.

Motor Vehicle Accidents

There was a total of (806) motor vehicle accidents investigated during this period. One (1) of these was fatal. During the same period for 2011 there were (746) motor vehicle accidents investigated, (1) of which was fatal. There was no change in fatal accidents. The total increase in accidents was 8% overall.

During this reporting period there were 136 child safety seats installed by officers of this department. During the same period for 2011 there were 195 child safety seats installed. A 30% decrease from the previous year.

Narcotics/Drugs

There were a total of twenty-four (24) drug related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2011 there were thirty-two (32) cases investigated. This was a 25% decrease from the previous year.

Sex Crimes Cases:

There were a total of ten (10) sex crime related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2011 there were ten (10) cases investigated. There was no change from the previous year.

Robbery Cases:

There were five (5) robbery cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2011 there was one (1) cases investigated. This was a 500% increase from the previous year. All of the cases occurred at different commercial locations and were unrelated. There were arrests made in three (3) of the cases.

Alarms All types

The department responded to a total of **1,442** alarms during this period. During the same period for 2011 the department responded to a total of **1,730** alarms. This was a **17%** decrease from the previous year.
