A set of systematic, analytical processes directed at providing timely and pertinent information relative to crime patterns and trend correlations to assist the operational and administrative personnel in planning the deployment of resources for the prevention and suppression of criminal activities, aiding the investigative process, and increasing apprehensions and the clearance of cases. Within this context, Crime Analysis supports a number of department functions including patrol deployment, special operations, and tactical units, investigations, planning and research, crime prevention, and administrative services (budgeting and program planning). --Steven Gottlieb et al., 1994, "Crime Analysis: From First Report To Final Arrest."

*During the month of August 2008. The Guilford Police Department had the following **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** Crimes reported: Reference Appendix A for further information.*

Burglary Cases

There were a total of two (2) burglaries reported during this period. One residential and one public property. Both are currently under investigation. The public property burglary was to the Guilford Library, this was a forced entry in which several new computers were taken. None of the cases showed a distinct pattern, further more no modes operandi was found. *Reference Appendix B for a graph representation.*

Criminal Mischief Cases:

Twenty-Two (26) criminal mischief cases were filed; nine were private property, twelve were mailbox damage, three were public property, and two were windows. Six cases were solved, two of which had a similar modes operandi. All the solved cases were handled between the complainants and the subjects. *Reference Appendix C for a graph representation.*

Larceny Cases:

Twenty-five (25) larceny complaints were filed. A detailed examination of these cases revealed the following details: Of the twenty-five cases, a total of three larceny cases were solved. All resulting in arrests. A total breakdown of the types of larceny cases are as follows: (2) shoplifting cases, (5) thefts from autos, (1) bicycle theft, (5) thefts from buildings, (2) auto accessory thefts, and (10) general larceny cases. A modes operandi was noted in the two theft of auto accessory cases. *Reference Appendix D for a graph representation.*

Robbery Cases:

An armed robbery occurred during this period. The incident occurred in the center of town to a bread delivery man. The suspect was armed with a handgun and fled in an older model light colored sedan. The victim was not physically injured in the incident. No similar incidents were reported by any other agencies in the area. This case is still active.

Information and Intelligence received on criminal activity:

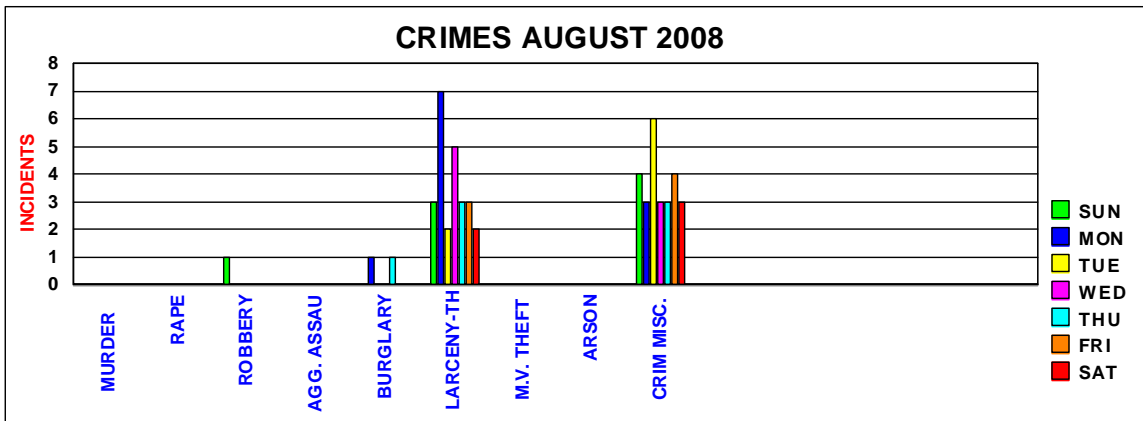

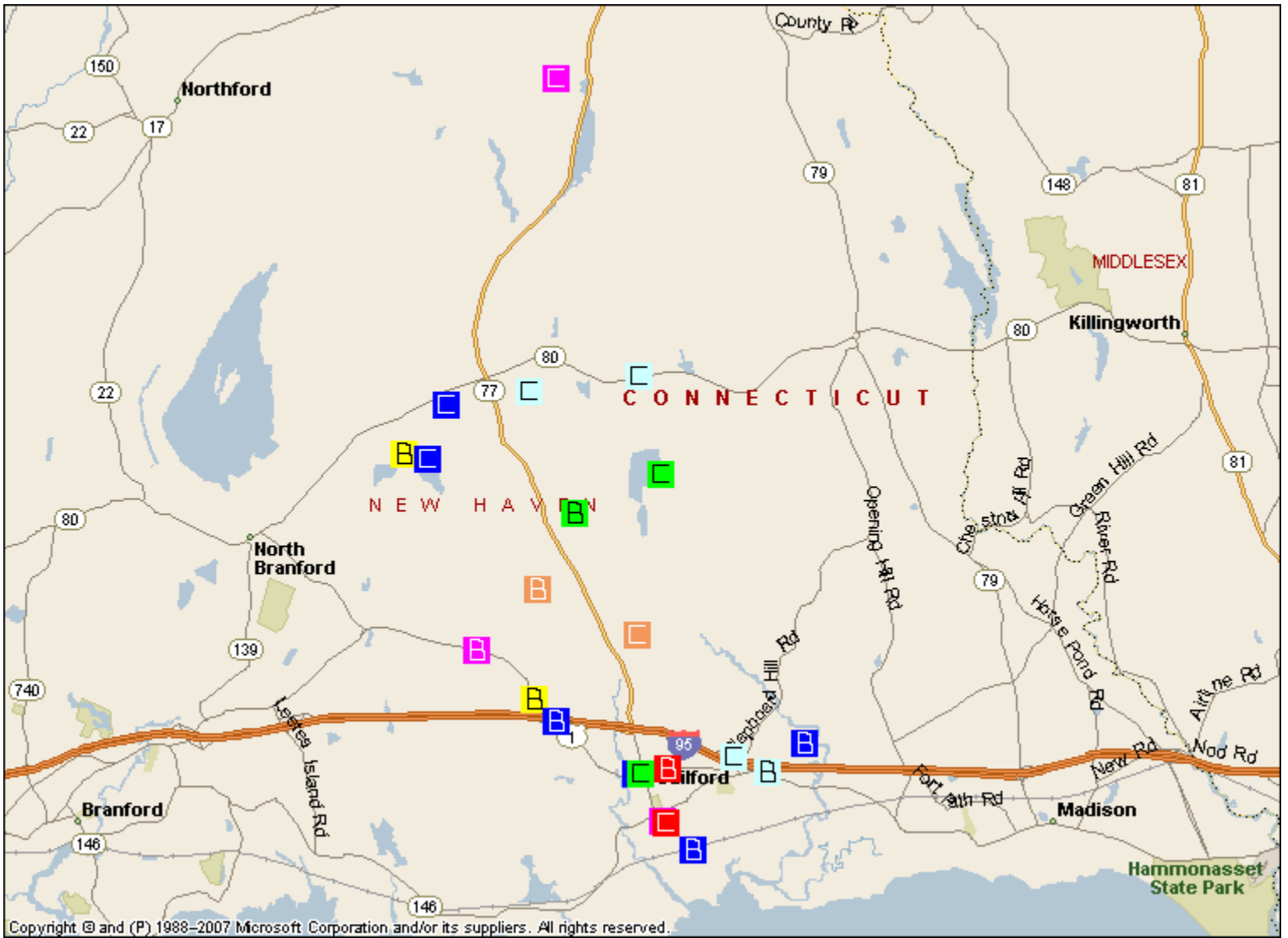




Burglary Cases for August 2008

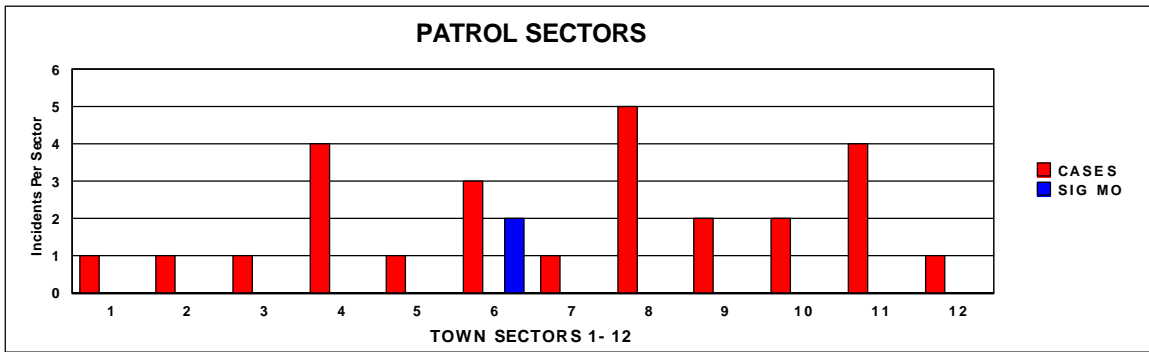
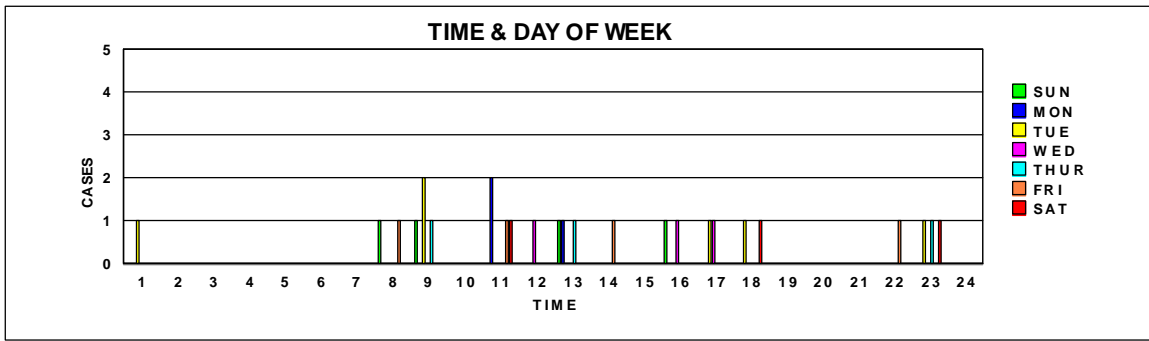
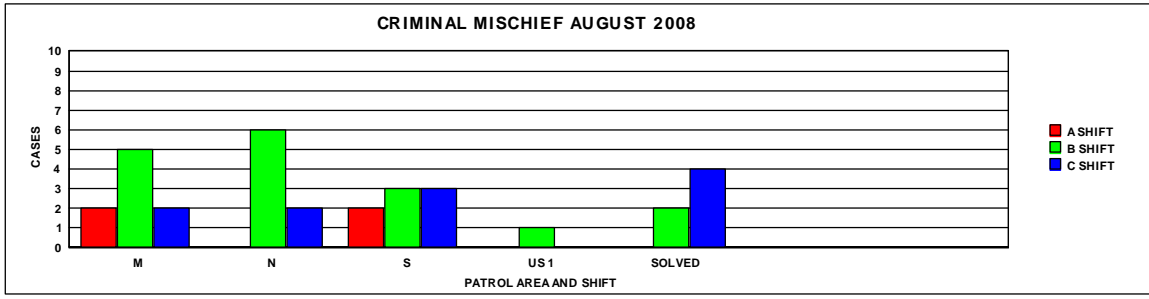

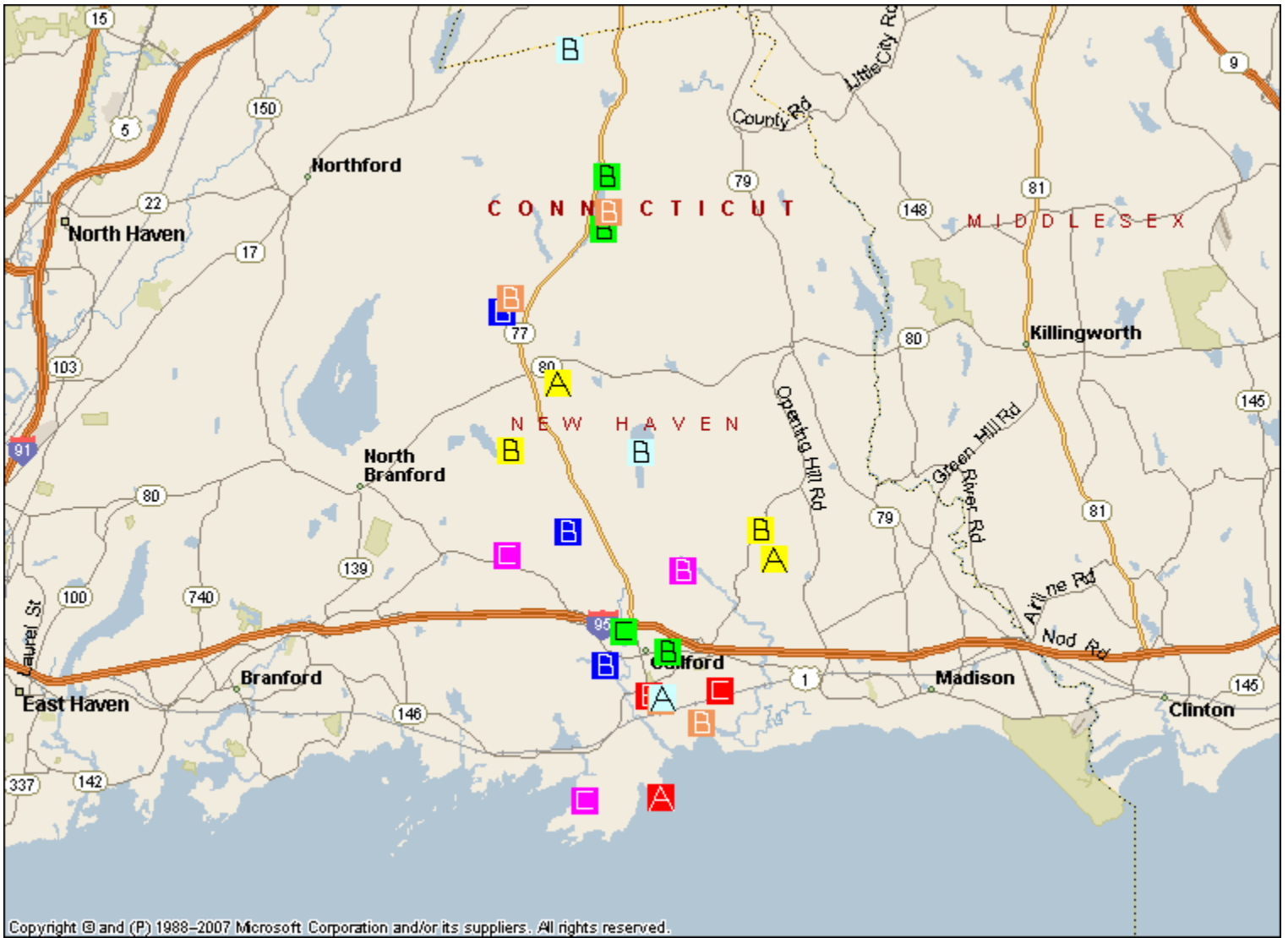




Larceny Case for August 2008
