SUBJECT: Annual Crime Analysis Report for 2014

The annual report includes general information on **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** crimes reported and investigated by the Guilford Police Department. The report also includes information on motor vehicle enforcement, accidents, and alarm cases investigated by this agency from **January 1**st, **2014 to December 31**st, **2014**. A comparison on all information is also listed for the previous year.

Calls for Service

During 2014 the Guilford Police Department received **11,772** calls for service. Of these calls the following information has been formulated for your review. During the same period in 2013 there were **11,916** calls for service. This was a **decrease** of **1.2** % in calls for service from the previous year.

Burglary Cases

There were a total of nineteen (19) burglaries reported during this period. The majority of which were residential in nature. During the same period for 2013 there were thirty-seven (37) reported burglaries in the jurisdiction. This was a 48.6% decrease from the previous year.

Criminal Mischief Cases:

There were a total of one hundred and thirty five (135) criminal mischief complaints reported during this period. The majority of which were private property and or mailbox damage. During the same period for 2013 there were one hundred and eighty three (183) cases reported. This was a nearly 26.2% decrease from the previous year.

Larceny Cases:

There were a total of four hundred and twenty three (423) larceny complaints filed during this period. The majority of which were classified as general larceny and larcenies from vehicles. In addition identify theft cases, and fraud cases have been added to this year's report. During the same period for 2013 there were two hundred and sixty four (264) cases reported. This was a 60.2% increase from the previous year.

Motor Vehicle Enforcement

There were a total of three thousand two hundred and forty (3,240) motor vehicle violations investigated during this period. During the same period for 2013 there were two thousand eight hundred and ninety eight (2,898) cases investigated. This was a 11.8% increase from the previous year.

There were twenty-four (24) DWI arrests in 2014 and forty two (42) DWI arrests in 2013. This was a 42.8% decrease from the previous year.

Motor Vehicle Accidents

There were a total of five hundred fifty eight (558) motor vehicle accidents investigated during this period. Two (2) of these were fatal. There were also ninety one (97) evading responsibility complaints investigated. During the same period for 2013 there were five hundred and forty three (543) motor vehicle accidents investigated, (3) of which were fatal. Fatal accidents decreased 33.3%. The total increase in accidents was 2.7% overall, not including evading complaints.

During this reporting period there were two hundred twenty five (225) child safety seats installed by officers of this department. During the same period for 2013 there were two hundred fifty nine (259) child safety seats installed. A 13.1% decrease from the previous year.

Narcotics/Drugs

There were a total of twenty-nine (29) drug related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2013 there were thirty-four (34) cases investigated. This was a nearly 14.7% decrease from the previous year.

Sex Crimes Cases:

There were a total of one hundred and eight (108) sex crime related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2013 there were five (5) cases investigated. There was a 2060% increase from the previous year. The dramatic increase is due to Detectives work with ICAC and mainly a single suspect creating several individual cases.

Robbery Cases:

There were two (2) robbery cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2013 there was zero (0) cases investigated. This was a 200% increase from the previous year.

Alarms All types

The department responded to a total of one thousand two hundred forty five (1,245) alarms during this period. During the same period for 2013 the department responded to a total of one thousand three hundred thirty two (1,332) alarms. This was a nearly 6.5% decrease from the previous year.

Murder Cases:

None reported

Arson Cases:

The department responded to a total of one (1) reported arson. During the same period for 2013, the department responded to a total of zero (0) reported arsons. This is a 100% increase from the previous year.
