On March 24th, 2018 at 0409hrs, the Guilford Police Department arrested three subjects who committed two commercial burglaries at cell phone stores in the area of Boston Post Road. Officers responded to the initial report of a commercial burglar alarm activation at 934 Boston Post Road, AT&T Get Wireless Now, which was determined to be a commercial burglary on arrival. Three subjects were captured as they were attempting to leave the area in a stolen motor vehicle. They were identified as Victor Molina (02/20/1985), James Brewton (06/11/1969), and Victoria Deon (02/20/1982). All three are from New York. Officers also discovered a second commercial burglary had occurred at 864 Boston Post Road, Verizon Wireless Zone. Entry was made into both stores by breaking windows. Cell phones and other merchandise were found to be missing from the stores. All three subjects were arrested (see charges below).

Information had been received prior to the incidents in Guilford that there were recent and similar commercial burglaries to cell phone stores in both Greenwich, CT and Orange, CT.

All three subjects were charged with the following offenses: Burglary in the First Degree (2 Counts), Conspiracy to Commit Burglary in the First Degree (2 counts), Larceny in the First Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Larceny in the First Degree, Criminal Mischief in the First Degree (2 Counts), Conspiracy to Commit Criminal Mischief in the First Degree (2 Counts), Larceny in the Fourth Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Larceny in the Fourth Degree, and Possession of Burglar Tools. Victor Molina was charged additionally with Interfering with an Officer. Victoria Deon was charged additionally with Failure to Obey a Traffic Signal. Bonds for all three subjects was set at \$100,000.00.
