SUBJECT: Annual Crime Analysis Report for 2017

DATE: January 9, 2018

The annual report includes general information on **Part 1** and selected **Part 2** crimes reported and investigated by the Guilford Police Department. The report also includes information on motor vehicle enforcement, accidents, and alarm cases investigated by this agency from **January 1**st 0000hrs, 2017 to December 31st 2359hrs, 2017. A comparison on all information is also listed for the previous year.

Calls for Service

During 2017 the Guilford Police Department received **11,993** calls for service. Of these calls the following information has been formulated for your review. During the same period in 2016 there were **12,665** calls for service. This was a **5.31** % **decrease** in calls for service from the previous year.

Burglary Cases

There was a total of thirty-one (31) burglaries reported during this period. The majority of which were residential in nature. During the same period for 2016 there were thirty-seven (37) reported burglaries in the jurisdiction. This was a 16.2% decrease from the previous year.

Criminal Mischief Cases:

There was a total of one hundred and forty-seven (147) criminal mischief complaints reported during this period. The majority of which were private property and/or mailbox damage. During the same period for 2016 there were one hundred and twenty-six (126) cases reported. This was a 16.6% increase from the previous year.

Larceny Cases:

There was a total of four hundred and thirty-three (433) larceny complaints filed during this period. The majority of which were classified as general larceny, larcenies from vehicles and shopliftings. Additionally, these figures reflect identify theft cases and fraud cases. During the same period for 2016 there were three hundred sixty-five (365) cases reported. This is a 18.63% increase from the previous year.

Motor Vehicle Enforcement

There was a total of three thousand six hundred and fourteen (3,614) motor vehicle violations investigated during this period (to include radar/laser speed enforcement and DWI enforcement). During the same period for 2016 there were four thousand and sixty (4,060) cases investigated. This was a 10.98% decrease from the previous year.

Included in the above statistic, there were forty one **(41) DWI** arrests in 2017 (both alcohol and drug related) compared to forty-two **(42) DWI** arrests in 2016. This was a **2.38% decrease** from the previous year.

Not included in the above statistic, the Guilford Police Department also investigated one hundred eighteen (118) parking violations in 2017.

Motor Vehicle Accidents

There was a total of seven hundred sixty-seven (767) motor vehicle accidents investigated during 2017. There were no fatal accidents. During the same period for 2016 there were six hundred ninety-seven (697) motor vehicle accidents investigated, (1) of which was fatal. Fatal accidents are down 100%. The total increase in accidents was 10.04% overall. Included in both sums are cases in which the responsible party evaded responsibility.

During 2017 there were two hundred and fifty-three (253) child safety seats installed by officers of this department. During the same period for 2016 there were two hundred and ninety-five (295) child safety seats installed. This is a 14.24% decrease from the previous year.

Narcotics/Drugs

There was a total of fifty (50) drug related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2016 there were forty-seven (47) cases investigated. This represents an overall **increase** of 6.38% for narcotics related investigations.

Sex Crimes Cases:

There were a total of sixteen (16) sex crime related cases investigated during this period. During the same period for 2016 there were sixteen (16) cases investigated. The amount remained the same from 2016 to 2017.

Robbery Cases:

There were no (0) robbery cases investigated during 2017. During the same period for 2016, there were (2) robbery cases investigated. This is a 100% decrease from the previous year.

Alarms - All Types

The department responded to a total of one thousand four hundred (1,400) alarms during 2017. During the same period for 2016, the department responded to a total of one thousand two hundred and eighty (1,280) alarms. This is a 9.38% increase from the previous year.

Guilford Police Department Forensic Laboratory

There were two hundred and twelve (212) items of evidence processed in the Guilford Police Department Forensic Laboratory in 2017. Various methods were utilized in the analyzation of these evidence items. This figure does not include items processed in the field.
