Press Release

On 12/22/2019, Members of the Guilford Police Department arrested Sylvia Delloro, 10/31/1975, on three (3) outstanding arrest warrants. Over the course of several months the department received multiple complaints accusing Delloro of taking credit card payments to provide airport transportation, then either not showing up for the scheduled transport to the airport or leaving the victims stranded at airports upon returning from their trips. In each instance, Delloro collected payment and refused to provide any refunds after failing to provide the service. Delloro is also accused of attempting to conduct additional fraudulent transactions on the victim's credit cards.

Delloro has been charged with multiple counts of Larceny, Payment Card Theft and Illegal Use of a Payment Card. She was released on court set bonds totaling \$14,500, with a court date scheduled for December 31, 2019 at New Haven Superior Court.

At this time, additional investigations are on-going into similar allegations.

The Guilford Police Department would like to remind the community to remain cautious in decisions to seek unofficial providers of these type of transportation services.
