#### 3.1 Signage/Enforcement

#### 3.1.1 Safe Streets Task Force

Commissioner Huguenel updated the Board of Police Commissioners on the Safe Streets Task Force. He reported that the task force committee hosted a public meeting and suggestions for road improvements were made. He indicated that the task force is moving forward with their effort to provide enhanced road safety for pedestrians. Discussion took place regarding some potential safe street projects (quick build ideas).

#### 3.1.2 Housing Authority-310 State Street

Ms. Angela Ross, Executive Director of the Housing Authority, presented traffic concerns in regard to the location of 310 State Street. She reported that the stone wall in front of the building was recently hit by an oncoming vehicle. She attributed the accident to speeding. Discussion took place and suggestions were made. It was agreed that the addition of a stop bar on the property may be beneficial for sightline improvements. The department will conduct a study at this location and report back with the results.
